Palliative Care Is Different

Palliative care differs from hospice care because the patient receiving palliative care **may pursue curative treatments.**



Qualifications

A person may receive palliative care regardless of life expectancy, whereas a hospice patient must have a terminal diagnosis and a life expectancy of less than six months.

Palliative care is supportive in nature; it can also be referred to as supportive care and **viewed as another layer of assistance for your well-being.**

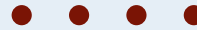

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SERENITY'S PEDIATRIC CARE

- Serenity actively accepts pediatric patients when most hospice organizations do not.
- Serenity staff are engaged in ongoing education designed to meet the unique needs of pediatric patients.
- Hospice and palliative care services are available for pediatric patients.

SERENITY'S TIMELINE

- **1984** Ogle County Hospice Association is established as a community-based organization with the first office in Rochelle, IL.
- **1995** The organization becomes a full-service, Medicare/Medicaid certified hospice.
- **2001** The first of three Angel Treasures resale shops opens in Oregon, IL. in support of hospice Care.
- **2002** Ogle County Hospice Association Foundation is established.
- **2009** Serenity Home openED off route 2 in Oregon, IL. in April, and served 50 patients and their families.
- **2011** Our Name changed to Serenity Hospice & Home.
- **2012** Serenity formed an alliance with KSB Hospital after they dissolved their hospice services.
- **2014** Partnership started with The Village of Progress for textile recycling.
- **2015** Serenity opens innovative bereavement center, The Serenity Shed in downtown oregon, il.
- **2016** Serenity Hospice & Home receives accreditation by the Joint Commission. Angel Treasures II opens in Winnebago.
- **2017** Serenity builds administration building.
- **2018** Serenity establishes The Palliative Care Program and adds massage therapy as a service for patients.
- **2022** Serenity receives A 5-STAR RATING (HIGHEST) IN THE new CMS rating system for quality of care. Serenity adds music therapy & virtual reality to THE list of integrative therapies.
- **2023** Angel Treasures III is opened in Dixon.
- **2024** Serenity Hospice & Home Celebrates 40 years of service.



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
