What's Been Happening?

The last three months of the year are always some of the busiest, but also the most rewarding, months at Serenity Hospice & Home.

In October, our volunteers helped prepare for the Angel Ball fundraiser and created beautiful wreaths for our veteran patients, spreading holiday cheer early. On Halloween, we had the privilege of participating in the Top of Illinois Stand Down, providing essentials to around 100 at-risk and homeless veterans.

November brought our Annual Memorial Event, honoring the patients we had the honor of caring for over the past year. We also renewed our Level 5 partnership with the We Honor Veterans program, celebrating the dedication of our veterans and the social workers who support them.

Volunteers helped bring joy to the next generation as well, reading military-themed books to students at Oregon Elementary School. Over the holiday season, volunteers delivered more than 50 Thanksgiving and

Christmas meals and helped adorn Serenity Home for the festivities. Our Angel Ball fundraiser was a tremendous success, thanks in large part to volunteers who decorated the event and ensured the evening ran smoothly. Volunteers also made over 45 candy tins for staff at nursing homes caring for our hospice patients and participated in Wreaths Across America, donating over 40 wreaths for the event.

We closed the year with our Comfy & Cozy Volunteer Christmas Party, a heartwarming celebration bringing together volunteers from every opportunity. The games, food, and gift exchange made it the perfect way to honor the year's work and community spirit.
